All transfer applications to Second, Third, Transition, Fifth or Sixth Year Group at Coachford College will only be accepted after 07/04/2025 and the closing date for receipt of applications is 02/05/2025 at 16:00. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Please be reminded that, in line with the School's Admissions Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply.
